During his time in the military, he deployed with the army to a forward operating base in Eastern Afghanistan where he spent seven months as the only psychiatrist in a combat stress clinic. While deployed, he treated hundreds of military personnel with combat stress related issues. He was honorably discharged from the Air Force in June of 2012 at the rank of Major. Dr. Owens continues to treat both retired and active duty military members and their dependents and understands the importance of the patients being as close as possible to their support system which includes their family, friends and military brethren. He is presently the Medical Director of the Geriatric Psychiatric Unit Seasons.

Ralph Burroughs is a board certified psychiatric nurse practitioner who has more than 15 years of experience providing care to a wide variety of psychiatric populations. He served in patient care roles, as well as, management roles at the Mississippi State Hospital before joining the United States Air Force in 2001 where he served for more than ten years providing both inpatient and outpatient psychiatric care to active duty service members, dependents, and military retirees. While on active duty, he deployed on two occasions in support of combat operations in Iraq and Afghanistan. During his last deployment, he was recognized by the Surgeon General of the Air Force for implementing a program to screen returning soldiers for traumatic brain injury and combat stress illnesses. Over 2,800 service members were treated as a result of these efforts. He was medically retired from the military as a Major and his military awards include a Meritorious Service Medal, The Air Force Achievement Medal, as well as numerous citations for providing outstanding leadership and patient care throughout his career. He continues to provide care to military members, dependents, and military retirees as well as provides geriatric psychiatric care at Garden Park Hospital.
